

The lady partridge lifted her wings and marched out her eight tiny offsprings with dad lurking in the background






Then, a cat entered in like a villain to upset the life of the happy partridge family and one night killed the father and four of the babies!!!

.....being watchful and vigilant for the adversaries






The beautiful Partridge family has given me invaluable "courtyard lessons" to fight, to survive, to grow and live together, to love and to be happy!!!






