- This case is recommended subject to following conditions:
1. The applicant will not start the college or give admission to the prospective students till a class permission to that effect has been issued by GOI/DCI.
 2. The applicant will follow all the directives issued by State Government from time to time.
 3. Admission to all the sanctioned seats will be strictly in accordance with the procedure and the guidelines given by the Hon'ble Supreme Court, GOI/DCI/MSI from time to time.
 4. The applicant will setup hospital and other infrastructure as per the Rules/regulations of DCI before starting the Dental College. The State Government will not allow attachment and other facilities for training to the students of the proposed Dental College.
 5. Fee structure will be got approved from the State Government in accordance with the Supreme Court/GOI/DCI directives.
 6. No Objection Certificate/No Objection Certificate will be valid only for two years from the date of issue.

The **Mahatma Gandhi Dental College & Hospital, RIICO intuitional Area Sitapura, Tonk Road Jaipur** has applied for Increase in BDS seats in dental college at **Jaipur**. On careful consideration of the proposal, the Government of Rajasthan has decided to issue an Essentially Certificate to the applicant for the increase of seats in **BDS Course from 60 to 100 seats**.

It is certified that: -

- The applicant owns and manages a 100 bedded hospital which was established in 2003.
- The applicant owns and manages a dental clinic with 121 chairs.
- It is desirable to increase seats in dental college in the public interest.
- The credibility and the financial status of the applicant have been verified.

It is further certified that in case the applicant fails to create infrastructure for the dental college as per Dental Council of India norms and fresh admissions are stopped by the Dental Council of India, the State Government shall take over the responsibility of the students already admitted in the College with the permission of the Central Government.
