- Admission/Admission enquiry portal will open. Fill the registration form.
- E-mail id entered by you shall be your USERID and mobile no. shall be your password to login the portal to access the admission application form.

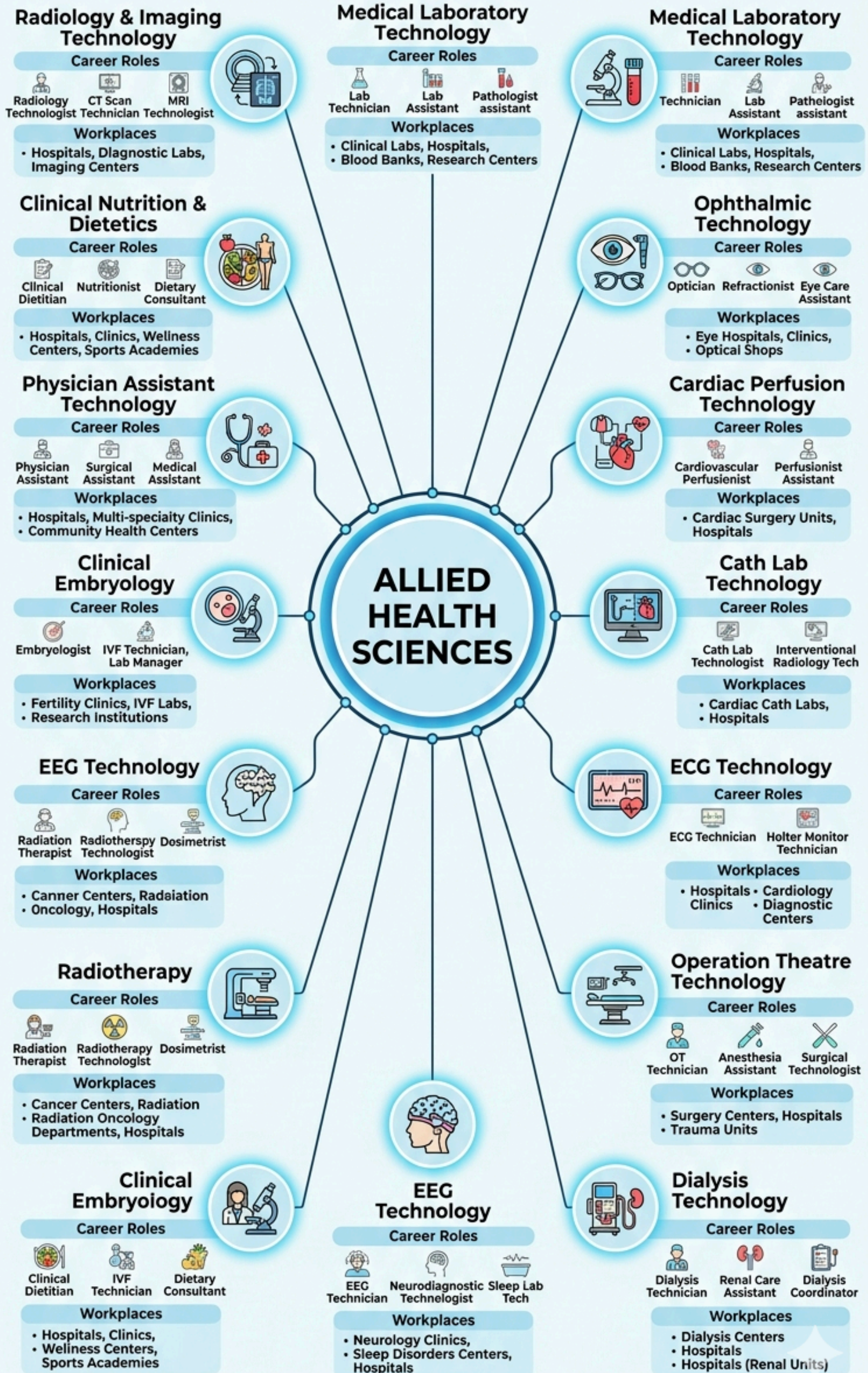
