Exemption from appearing at the written Entrance Test –

Candidates who have qualified for a fellowship or scholarship through UGC-NET / UGC-CSIR NET/ GATE/ CEED or any other equivalent national tests in their relevant discipline are exempted from appearing in the written entrance test of the university.

Such candidates shall participate in the interaction with admission board, which will assess their research aptitude, proposal, and suitability for the PhD program. Admission offers will be based on the outcome of this interaction.

Eligibility -

- 1. Candidates who qualify UGC-NET in a particular subject are eligible for admission to PhD programs in that subject. Their valid UGC-NET score shall be considered for admission to Ph.D. program.
- 2. Candidates other than UGC-NET qualified:
 - i. Candidates who have completed 1-year/2-semester master's degree programme after a 4-year/8-semester bachelor's degree programme or a 2-year/4-semester master's degree programme after a 3-year bachelor's degree programme or qualifications declared equivalent to the master's degree by the corresponding statutory regulatory body, with at least 55% marks in aggregate (Except Nursing) or its equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed or equivalent qualification from a foreign

educational institution accredited by an assessment and accreditation agency which is approved, recognized or authorized by an authority, established or incorporated under a law in its home country or any other statutory authority in that country to assess, accredit or assure quality and standards of the educational institution.

A relaxation of 5% marks or its equivalent grade may be allowed for those belonging to SC/ST/OBC (non-creamy layer)/Differently-Abled, Economically Weaker Section (EWS) and other categories of candidates as per the decision of the Commission from time to time.

Provided that a candidate seeking admission after a 4-year/8-semester bachelor's degree programme should have a minimum of 75% marks in aggregate or its equivalent grade on a point scale wherever the grading system is followed. A relaxation of 5% marks or its equivalent grade may be allowed for those belonging to SC/ST/OBC (non-creamy layer)/Differently-Abled, Economically Weaker Section (EWS) and other categories of candidates as per the decision of the Commission from time to time.

ii. Applicants of Ph.D. Program in Nursing:

- a. Must hold a M.Phil. (Nursing) or M.Sc. (Nursing) or any other Postgraduate degree in Nursing recognized by Indian Nursing Council (INC) with a minimum of 3 years teaching or clinical experience after completing their M.Sc. (Nursing). Ph.D. in Nursing (part-time) will be allowed those, presently working in MGUMST.
- b. All applicants must have secured at least 60% marks in their M.Sc. (Nursing) degree.

iii. Applicants of Ph.D. Program in Health Information Management:

A candidate seeking admission to a Ph.D. program shall have successfully completed a two (2) year Master's degree program in the relevant/related subject after a four (4) years undergraduate program with at least 55% marks in aggregate or its equivalent from a recognised university.

Admission -

Admissions to Ph.D. program shall be made through Written Entrance Test and Interaction on Research Aptitude.

Criteria for selection:

1. Faculties other than the Faculty of Nursing

Candidates who obtain a minimum of 50% marks in the written entrance test will be eligible to appear for the interaction. A relaxation of 5% in the entrance test marks will be provided to candidates belonging to SC/ST/OBC, differently-abled categories, Economically Weaker Sections (EWS), and other categories as per the prevailing guidelines of the Commission.

The final selection will be based on a weighted evaluation, with 70% weightage given to the marks obtained in the Entrance Test and 30% to the performance during the Interaction.

2. Faculty of Nursing

Selection shall be based on (i) Entrance test marks obtained out of 90 marks (ii) 5 marks for candidates possessing M.Phil. in Nursing (iii) 5 marks weightage for publications.

Candidates who secure 60% marks i.e. 54 out of maximum 90 marks in the Written Entrance Test shall be called for the interaction for admission to Ph.D. course.

Provisional admission will be granted by the University's Admission Board after verifying the candidate's eligibility.

Applicants must submit the online application via the university admission portal within the specified deadline outlined in this notification.

To complete the application for Ph.D. programs listed, submission of all required documents and payment of the entrance test fee are mandatory prerequisites.

- It lacks the necessary enclosures (e.g., documents, certificates).
- The prescribed fee has not been paid.

Only fully completed applications with all enclosures and fees submitted will be accepted.

If, at any point - even after clearing the entrance test – it's determined that a candidate does not meet the eligibility criteria, provisional admission granted by the Admission Board shall be revoked and all fees paid shall be forfeited.

All legal disputes and court proceedings related to this admission process shall fall exclusively within the jurisdiction of the Jaipur Bench of the Hon'ble Rajasthan High Court.
