**Eligibility –**

1. Candidates who qualify UGC-NET in a particular subject are eligible for admission to PhD programs in that subject. Their valid UGC-NET score shall be considered for admission to Ph.D. program.
2. Candidates other than UGC-NET qualified:
  - i. Candidates who have completed 1-year/2-semester master's degree programme after a 4-year/8-semester bachelor's degree programme or a 2-year/4-semester master's degree programme after a 3-year bachelor's degree programme or qualifications declared equivalent to the master's degree by the corresponding statutory regulatory body, with at least 55% marks in aggregate (Except Nursing) or its equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed or equivalent qualification from a foreign educational institution accredited by an assessment and accreditation agency which is approved, recognized or authorized by an authority, established or incorporated under a law in its home country or any other statutory authority in that country to assess, accredit or assure quality and standards of the educational institution.

A relaxation of 5% marks or its equivalent grade may be allowed for those belonging to SC/ST/OBC (non-creamy layer)/Differently-Abled, Economically Weaker Section (EWS) and other categories of candidates as per the decision of the Commission from time to time.

Provided that a candidate seeking admission after a 4-year/8-semester bachelor's degree programme should have a minimum of 75% marks in aggregate or its equivalent grade on a point scale wherever the grading system is followed. A relaxation of 5% marks or its equivalent grade may be allowed for those belonging to SC/ST/OBC (non-creamy layer)/Differently-Abled, Economically Weaker Section (EWS) and other categories of candidates as per the decision of the Commission from time to time.

**ii. Applicants of Ph.D. Program in Nursing:**

- a. Must hold a M.Phil. (Nursing) or M.Sc. (Nursing) or any other Postgraduate degree in Nursing recognized by Indian Nursing Council (INC) with a minimum of 3 years teaching or clinical experience after completing their M.Sc. (Nursing). Ph.D. in Nursing (part-time) will be allowed those, presently working in MGUMST.
- b. All applicants must have secured **at least 60% marks** in their M.Sc. (Nursing) degree.

**iii. Applicants of Ph.D. Program in Health Informatics:**

A Candidate seeking admission to a Ph.D. program shall have completed 1-year/2-semester master's degree programme after a 4-year/8-semester bachelor's degree programme or a 2-year/4-semester master's degree programme after a 3-year bachelor's degree programme or qualifications declared equivalent to the master's degree by the corresponding statutory regulatory body, with at least 55% marks in aggregate or its equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed or equivalent qualification from a foreign educational institution accredited by an assessment and accreditation agency which is approved, recognized or authorized by an authority, established or incorporated under a law in its home country or any other statutory

Nursing/ Master of Physiotherapy/ Master of Pharmacology/ Master of Occupational Therapy/Master in Public Health/ Master degree in social work (with any certificate/ diploma/degree related to Health Informatics, one-year professional experience in the field of Health Informatics).

In case of a 4-year/8-semester bachelor's degree programmes the degrees in mentioned above disciplines will be eligible.

## **Admission –**

Admissions to Ph.D. program shall be made through Written Entrance Test and Interaction on Research Aptitude.

### **Criteria for selection:**

#### **1. Faculties other than the Faculty of Nursing**

Candidates who obtain a minimum of 50% marks in the written entrance test will be eligible to appear for the interaction. A relaxation of 5% in the entrance test marks will be provided to candidates belonging to SC/ST/OBC, differently-abled categories, Economically Weaker Sections (EWS), and other categories as per the prevailing guidelines of the Commission.

The final selection will be based on a weighted evaluation, with 70% weightage given to the marks obtained in the Entrance Test and 30% to the performance during the Interaction.

#### **2. Faculty of Nursing**

Selection shall be based on (i) Entrance test marks obtained out of 90 marks (ii) 5 marks for candidates possessing M.Phil. in Nursing (iii) 5 marks weightage for publications.

Candidates who secure 60% marks i.e. 54 out of maximum 90 marks in the Written Entrance Test shall be called for the interaction for admission to Ph.D. course.

### **Selection Procedure**

#### **Written Entrance Examination**

Admission shall be based on a university-conducted entrance test held for each academic discipline. The entrance exam will be of 60 minutes duration and of 100 marks, consisting of 50 MCQs. The entrance test shall have two sections, as given below:

- **Section I: GENERAL:** 25 MCQs shall be common to all the applicants for testing research aptitude, covering questions from Research Methodology and Biostatistics
- **Section II: PROGRAM/SUBJECT SPECIFIC:** 25 MCQs shall be as per the applicant's proposed PhD program
- Each question will have four options, but only one option will be the correct answer. Each question in Section I and Section II carries 2 marks. There shall be no negative marking for wrong answers.

The qualifying mark for the entrance test shall be 50%. However, candidates belonging to SC/ST/OBC (Non-Creamy Layer)/EWS/PwD categories shall be given a relaxation of 5%, making the minimum qualifying mark 45%, in accordance with UGC regulations (As per the Notification issued by Secretary, UGC dated August 27, 2018 published in the Gazette of India (Extraordinary) Part-III Section IV No. 325 dated August 27, 2018).

**For Faculty of Nursing - Selection shall be based on**

- (i) Entrance test marks obtained out of 90 marks

(ii) 5 marks for candidates possessing M.Phil. in Nursing (iii) 5 marks weightage for publications. Candidates who secure 60% marks i.e. 54 out of maximum 90 marks in the Written Entrance Test shall be called for the interaction for admission to Ph.D. course.

- **Section I: GENERAL:** 25 MCQs shall be common to all the applicants for testing research aptitude, covering questions from Research Methodology and Biostatistics
- **Section II: PROGRAM/SUBJECT SPECIFIC:** 20 MCQs shall be as per the applicant's proposed PhD program
- Each question will have four options, but only one option will be the correct answer. Each question in Section I and Section II carries 2 marks. There shall be no negative marking for wrong answers.

Provisional admission will be granted by the University's Admission Board after verifying the candidate's eligibility.

Applicants must submit the online application via the university admission portal within the specified deadline outlined in this notification.

To complete the application for Ph.D. programs listed, submission of all required documents and payment of the entrance test fee are mandatory prerequisites.

If, at any point - even after clearing the entrance test – it's determined that a candidate does not meet the eligibility criteria, provisional admission granted by the Admission Board shall be revoked and all fees paid shall be forfeited.**
