Important Instructions:

Before attending the counselling, candidates are advised to self-check and ensure their eligibility in all respects for admission to the course they have applied for. Candidates who do not fulfill the eligibility shall not be allowed to appear before the Admission Board for the counselling. **Candidates whose results of the qualifying examination are still awaited, shall not be allowed to appear before the Admission Board.**

Following relevant Original Documents and one set of self-attested photocopy of the documents are to be brought by the candidate at the time of counselling otherwise the candidate shall not be considered for counselling:

- Mark Sheets/Certificate of the Secondary Examination (10th Class) showing **Date of Birth**.
- Mark Sheets/Certificate of Senior Secondary (10+2) or its Equivalent Examination.
- Marks Sheet of Qualifying Examination, (as mentioned in the “**Eligibility**” column of Admission Notification No. 3, already available on University Website)
- Transfer Certificate from the Institute last attended.
- Character Certificate from the Head of the Institute last attended.
- Valid Certificate for Reservation Category except General category candidates (EWS/ SC/ ST/ OBC-NCL/ MBC-NCL etc.).
 - **OBC-NCL/MBC-NCL Certificate should not be older than 1 (One) Year, on the day of Counselling.**
 - **The EWS Certificate must be issued for the financial year 2026–2027.**
- Domicile Certificate.
- Self-attested photocopy of Aadhar Card.
- Disability Certificate, if applicable.
- No Objection Certification (NoC)/ Permission from the present employer (Only for Inservice Candidates applying for regular Full-Time Program)
- Migration Certificate from concerned Board or University (For candidates except already enrolled with MGUMST, Jaipur.)
- Other Relevant Certificate(s), if any.
- Medical fitness certificate duly endorsed by Government Medical Officer.

Reservation of Seats: Reservation of Seats for admission shall be made as per the **Reservation Policy of Government of Rajasthan**.

Other State candidates belonging to any reserved category shall be treated as General Category Candidate.

Note -

1. In case, it is found that a candidate does not fulfill the conditions of eligibility prescribed as per the admission notification, the University shall cancel his/her admission at any stage even after admission.
2. Candidates shall have to abide by all Rules/Regulations of the University.
3. The University reserves the right to make changes in the Guidelines, Fee- Structure or any other information any time without prior notice. The decision of the University shall be binding on all.
4. All disputes in relation to the matters pertaining to admission to any of the above courses of the University shall be subject to the jurisdiction of Hon'ble Rajasthan High Court, Jaipur Bench only and not at any other place.
